We are going to keep working on that because my teeth are in good shape and if we get the tartar scraped off, I won't have to have a dental cleaning this year. My foster Mom is a lot stricter than my first Mom so I am learning that I have to do what she says. Snapping doesn't make her go away and leave me alone and barking doesn't make things happen any faster at all. I've learned a lot since I've been living with my foster Mom and now sleep in a crate without fussing and eat two meals a day instead of snacking all day.
