Rules of Eligibility

We were approached by CKC last year to approve the Rules of Eligibility (ROE) for Papillons. The CKC gave us the ROE that they had drawn up and the Board has gone back and forth with the document a number of times and Louann Hansen met with the ROE committee via zoom. We would like to propose the following and want to make sure our members are aware of the proposal and to give you this chance for input. Once the ROE has been approved, we, as breeders, will be required to attest that both parents of any litter we register meet the ROE.

Registrations of purebred dogs by CKC are governed by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada under the Animal Pedigree Act. The Act requires a general description for each breed recognized within CKC's By-laws for basic recognition and registration purposes. These descriptions are called the Rules of Eligibility (ROE). The traits described within the ROE need to reflect the physical essence of the breed and must be observable and measurable, e.g. size, colour, coat, etc. ROE are **not** used for show purposes or judging. The CKC would like to keep the ROE for each breed at approximately 50 words. For the purpose of the ROE, the following general categories of size shall be applied:

VERY SMALL	Under 12 inches	up to 15 pounds
SMALL	12 – 15 inches	15 – 40 pounds
MEDIUM	15 – 24 inches	40 – 65 pounds
LARGE	24 – 30 inches	65 – 80 pounds
VERY LARGE	over 30 inches	over 80 pounds

Height shall be measured at the highest point of the withers.

Rules of Eligibility – Papillon

Breed:	Papillon
Size:	Very Small
Coat Colour:	Patches on a white coat background
Colour Markings:	Patches of any colour other than white covering both ears and eyes.
Coat Texture/Length:	Long, silky, without undercoat
Body:	Slightly longer than tall, level topline
Ear Shape/Placement:	Large, rounded tip, mobile. Carried erect (Papillon- Butterfly) or dropped (Phalene-Moth)
Tail Shape/Carriage:	Set high, carried arched over the body
Feet:	Thin, hare-like.
Unique Characteristics:	Erect or Dropped ears
Genetic/Observable	
Variability:	Erect or Dropped Ears

Papillon Canada Rescue - BC Report – March 2023

Happy New Year! Or maybe I should be saying Happy Easter!

It's been awhile since I last wrote a Rescue Report for our All Ears Newsletter.

Covid, I believe, sent us all into a bit of a tailspin, I think. Hopefully, we are near the end of it, so we can continue where we left off!

During the Covid pandemic, I did take in a little Papillon from a very close friend of mine who ran Agility with me over the years. At that time, she had 2 Cavalier King Charles Spaniels that she was attempting to run in our Agility classes. We would always chuckle because the very last thing this pair was good at was socializing with the Ring crew, which of course left my friend, Evelyn, running the course all alone! She would watch my Papillons running the courses with envy, as most Papillons make wonderful Agility partners.

Time passed and Evelyn lost her 2 Spaniels, when they each crossed over the Rainbow Bridge. Shortly afterward, she started her search for a Papillon Agility partner. Soon she found Casper, a young Papillon puppy from a local breeder here on the West Coast. Casper was a very sweet, gentle, little fellow who, much to Evelyn's disappointment, also had absolutely no desire to run Agility either!

Sadly, after having Casper for only 20 months, my friend, Evelyn, passed away from Cancer, leaving Casper to me in her Will, hopefully to continue his career in Agility. Casper is still not interested in Agility. Unfortunately, not all dogs are cut out for this sport. However, I was able to find his calling. Casper, along with 3 of my Papillons all visit a special group, spending time with patients who are recovering from drug addiction, in one way or another. Most are youths who truly are so very gentle and kind to all the dogs that visit them. I personally find these visits very rewarding, just being there and observing the tenderness they show and give to my little dogs. I'm sure that Evelyn would be very happy to know that little Casper has found his calling as a Therapy Dog, which he does very well.

Now to Papillon Rescue News... Just last week I received a message from a young man who needed to surrender his 12 year old neutered, male Papillon, who he had purchased from a local breeder here on the lower mainland, 10 years ago or more. The reason for the surrender was the same that I hear WAY too often in Rescue - "We now have a baby so we don't have time for the dog. He's stressed out all the time and the baby, who is now crawling around, is terrifying the dog by trying to grab at his legs!"



I requested that the owner meet me with his Pap, Dexter, at my Vet Clinic, only to find out that poor Dexter had not seen a Vet since 2016! So the Vet did a complete Blood panel on him to rule out any internal concerns, with surprising results coming back clear. However, Dexter is extremely underweight, which is likely due to his teeth being severely under cared for. What is left of them was heartbreaking for me. One rotten tooth is even sticking straight out of his little mouth. No wonder he is so thin, with a mouth full of rotting teeth! In my mind, this neglect is a form of cruelty.

Needless to say, Dexter is now in desperate need of a dental, which due to his age, it would be safer for him to go to a Dental Specialist. We are fortunate enough to have one here in my area on the West Coast. Clients come from all over BC and sometimes beyond, to have their pet's teeth looked after, at West Coast Veterinary Dental Specialists.



This will be Dexter's FIRST and only dental in his life! Again, very, very sad. My plea to all our Papillon Canada Club members who support our Rescue is to please consider donating towards the cost of Dexter's dental surgery. His dental procedure will likely cost around \$ 3000.00. If many pitch in, with whatever we can afford to donate for Dexter's dental, maybe we can come close to covering the cost. My other Rescue organization, Little Paws Rescue, is also offering to help out with the costs.

Just a foot note... 99% of all the dogs that are surrendered into Little Paws Rescue here on the West Coast, ALL require a huge amount of dental work.

Thank you in advance for considering a donation to help Dexter.

Tips for Terrific PHONE Photos

Focus | Exposure | HDR

Focus on your subject by holding your finger on the camera screen – you will see a box around your subject, indicating where the focus is.

Here the finger was on Evie's face. The cameras have gotten really good with focus, so I rarely use this unless I want the background blurred.



Choose your time for great exposure, eg: shooting in the Golden hour before sunset.



The main attributes of this photo are the rich colours. Any other hour of the day and this shot would have been just too boring to keep.

HDR: in Settings, select for Auto HDR (High Dynamic Range) – this captures more details in the bright and dark areas of your shot and increases vibrancy, too.

Although backlit, Patches' face is still full of detail and not just a black blob, and HDR also brought out his warm brown highlights.



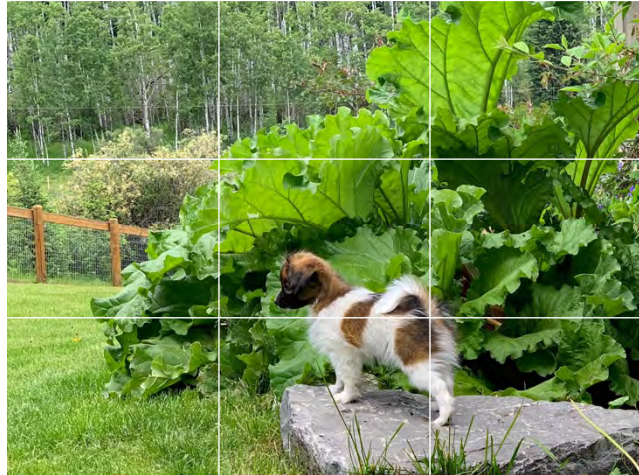
Tips for Terrific PHONE Photos

Rule of thirds:

Android: Grid icon at edge of screen

iOS: Camera settings, Grid

The idea is you want to line up your main subject on one those lines and on or very near one of the 4 intersections. It makes for a balanced composition which showcases your main subject.



Change the angle: get low!



Above left is a photo of a perennial cinquefoil, native to Alberta, which the birds planted right next to my front sidewalk. So ho-hum, right? Right is a bug's eye view of the same. 😊

Below is a low angle photo of papillons at the Rotary Mattamy Greenway at 90th Ave SW.



Tips for Terrific PHONE Photos

Basic edits:

Straighten that horizon!

What do you do if there isn't a 'horizon' in your photo? Use the verticals. Pick something near the vertical center of your photo – in this case I picked the street sign in the distance, but it can be a tree, a power pole, the side of a building. Rotate your photo until that element is perfectly 90° ... your phone will make this easy: Select your photo. Click edit. Click on the rotate icon. It will give you a grid to help you line it up.



Crop down to the essentials!



What is essential is entirely up to you. Above, the left photo showcases the lovely garden and setting of my friend's property, and the dogs are incidental. Same photo cropped tight to mom and pup only hints at the pretty place they are in; now they are the stars.

In straightening the picture, I rotated the photo so the fence post just to the right of the pup (the nearest to the middle) was vertical.

Of all the photos I take, I would say that 95% of my keepers get some cropping, some rotating – it is just an easy, basic thing that helps your photos tell their story without distractions.

Tips for Terrific PHONE Photos

What your phone won't do:

Neither your phone nor mine would have taken this picture of a Savannah sparrow.

This bird is just a little smaller than our city house sparrows. It was some 50 yards away from where I was, just a little speck in the distance. The only reason I saw it at all was because of the pretty song it was singing, so I was really looking for it.

I took this photo with my small Canon PowerShot SX720 HS camera with 40x optical zoom – and it is that amazing zoom that our phones are not yet capable of.

Considering the incredible strides phone cameras have made so far, I don't doubt but that this will come too!
