Papillon Canada Rescue Report

September 2023

After a few quiet years on the Papillon Canada Rescue scene in Ontario, we had a fairly busy summer. We had 3 Rescues surrendered into our care. First, there was "Pumpkin," a beautiful 11-year-old boy who had actually been adopted through our Rescue, just over 10 years ago. His owner passed away and she had made arrangements in her Will for him to come back to our Rescue. He did need some vaccinations updated and his teeth cleaned. But after that was done, he was put up for adoption and ended up as a foster failure. His foster parents fell in love with him and he adores them. So, it was a match that was meant to be.





Next, we had "Poppy," who was actually in Alberta. Poppy is a 10.5-year-old girl who's 94 year- old owner had to move into a care home. At first, we were asked if we could foster Poppy until a decision was made by the family. But Poppy ended up staying with a family member for a month. Then they reached out again and said a decision had been made to surrender Poppy to Rescue. This was a time sensitive surrender because the family, who had taken her in, would be traveling mid September and she needed to be placed. Well, that didn't take long. Less than 2

weeks later Poppy is in her forever home and apparently has settled right in.

Finally, we have "Bentley," a 6-year-old male. He is currently being fostered in the Niagara region of Ontario. He is a healthy dog and will have his Vet check-up this week. After he has been seen by the Vet, we will review the applications we have received for him and get him into his forever home.



It is calendar time again. Once again, Papillon Canada Rescue will be depending on financial support from the sale of the 2024 calendars to fund the care of the Papillons who come into our Rescue. The cost of calendars will be the same as last year - \$30 to sponsor a month, \$20 per calendar and \$5 shipping for up to 3 calendars. 






Memories A-Blaze



In mid-August, the lives of many BC residents, including my husband and I, were disrupted by devastating wildfires raging in the Okanogan.

August 15 - Tuesday seemed like an ordinary morning doing my normal routine with my dogs, enjoying coffee sitting at my computer organizing projects on my schedule when a news bulletin appeared about the wild fires in the Okanagan and there was a new one that started at McDougall Creek 37 hectors in size. At first, I needed to understand what a hector was, which is about the size of a football field. For some reason I had a bad feeling about the McDougall Creek wildfire and how close it was to my location. The rest of the day was just like a normal day.

Wednesday, August 16 started the day like any other, except my concern about the McDougall fire. In 24 hrs it now had doubled in size to 67 hectors. I knew it was near my home but there were no helicopters or planes in the area. I didn't know what to do other than just keep monitoring the news.

Thursday, August 17 morning news reported nothing. The West Kelowna Fire Chief announced that the fire grew from 67 hectors to 6700 hectors overnight. Fire was coming closer and closer to the city of West Kelowna.



It became apparent that this fire was coming across the mountain into and toward the Okanagan Lake. An Evacuation Alert was implemented on over 1100 properties which included my home. I registered with cordemergency.ca (Central Okanagan



Emergency Operations) and my husband and I packed our van after taking pictures/videos of every room in the house.


We saw several planes flying overhead, but no helicopters, and nothing that looked like it had water buckets.

There were wildfires north and south of us which were stretching resources were thin. At 7pm the amount of plume and smoke to the north of us was very upsetting. We then decided to start moving our vehicles. For some reason, I had a feeling that I needed to take my two dogs on the first trip down the hill. It took us only about 10 mins to drive across the bridge to where we deposited the car. When we came back to get access to our

area which was still under evacuation alert, we were told it was a hard block. I was almost ill thinking that I had not acted on my gut instinct to take the dogs. We drove to a friend's place. That night we literally had our two dogs, the clothes on our backs, and ID but were fortunate and blessed to be safe. I have to say - if you have a gut feeling - act on that gut feeling because the dogs could have been in peril because a hard block is for the safety of the community and effectiveness of the evacuation operations. That night the winds were so fierce they jumped the 5km lake and started 2 more fires on the east side.



Friday, the fire reversed directions. Now with 3 wildfires blazing. Now the number of people that were




affected has increased tremendously. The winds blowing southward resulted in the fire overcoming many of the homes in West Kelowna. At this point 15 homes in our community of 30 community alone were burned in the afternoon. In all over 200 homes were destroyed, in this one area. Red (Evacuation Order) – Yellow (Evacuation Alert)

We stayed with friends for about a week, but then moved to a hotel. On Sept 2 we were allowed access to our neighborhood. Our home was one of the 50% still standing. The amount of devastation is unreal. I'm not going to compare it to anything, as I have never seen anything like this, expect on TV. It is heart-wrenching every time we drive to our house. Some of our neighbors have houses that look like papier-mâché. It is hard to imagine what they and others are going through.

Although we have insurance, we are finding there are more and more that did not have enough coverage. We were without power for over two weeks, and therefore, all our fridges and freezers were condemned as biohazards, so we had to get them removed and order new ones. The fire came very close to our home and it destroyed houses behind and in front of us plus several houses in the immediate vicinity.

It's September 20 and the fire is still uncontained. It moved to the southern area of West Kelowna, but the fire fighters were successful in holding it back to the forest areas only. Several cleaning companies are currently working on our home, cleaning outside, inside, vents, etc. The cleaning, replacement and repairs will take time, its not going to happen to quickly, that's for sure.





The positive news is that no lives were lost due to the fire, so far. This week a new fire started just south of us. The cause of the McDougall Fire (Aug 15) is unknown sadly, this new fire Glen Lake (Sept 17) was human caused. I'm attaching a picture of the Glen Lake fire, that I took from my hotel room in West Kelowna. The smoke and wind were brutal. This is the new fire map (on Sept 20). The Blue dot is my home away from home.

We were not able to access our RV throughout this ordeal and so we have been in a hotel for the past month. We are hoping to back in our home by Sept 25







