In September, Rush (*Animato Anacott Divine Amber AGN AGNJ JTX2 S*) earned her Novice Agility, Ravier (*BISS BPISS GCH Pixel Animato A Link Between Worlds RATN JT S*) had some stellar runs and collected some more Qs towards his next titles, Ecco (*GCH Marrons N Flinters Be Dazzled AGN AGNJ JTX AS*) collected a few more Qs towards her Jumps and Tunnels Excellent 2 title, and Mipha (*Pixel Breath Of The Wild RATI JT NS*) made her agility debut and went 3/3 perfect runs to earn her Jumps and Tunnels Title! My pups participated in a Barn Hunt Fun Match earlier this year. With very little practice, I threw them into a full trial this fall. Barn Hunt is pretty instinctual, and the challenging part is trying to read your dog's body language. In Alberta, we are "rat-free" so we do not use rats in the tubes. We use a single gerbil, which throws off a much smaller scent and thermal signature. On top of that, the trial was held in a doggy daycare, so it smelled... like a dog run (shit included...). My guys persisted and did pretty well considering. Ravier turned out to be the best hunter. He earned his RATI (Instinct) and RATN (Novice) titles without fail. His best Novice level run was in 39.87 seconds, which was wickedly fast (or so I was told, lol). Mipha also earned her RATI title, although we are both not sure if it was just a fluke. The dogs seem to love this sport and I am looking forward to more trials next year.

On the showing side, Mipha is slowly working her way towards her championship. She has determined that I am the only person she needs and that judges don't give out cookies, so they are stupid. Ha! I am hoping that time and maturity will kick in at some point... as she is a pretty girl, she just needs to show herself. I have also been keen to try showing Ravier and Mipha as a Brace, so I pulled Ravier off the couch for the Camrose show. They did really well together and won Best Brace in Group and showed very competitively in the Best Brace in Show ring. We lost to a pair of Sammies, but I am very happy with how they did and we got lots of compliments.

My dogs and I had an amazing year of trying out many new things. It was a blast and I am excited to see what 2024 will bring!

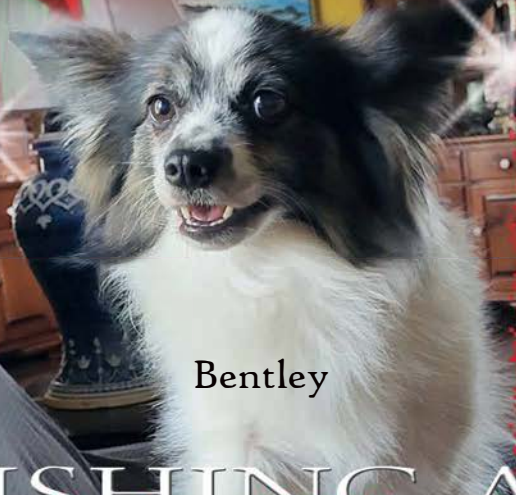

Message for Newbies to Papillons,

I'm excited to see more and more newbies at the dog shows but there's a lesson I learned very early on that seems to escape the newbies of today.

“We are only as good as the breeders we associate ourselves with”

This means that if you buy your show dog from a BYB or a Breeder that has earned a bad reputation, the hills you have to climb are going to be much steeper and require more laborious work to acquire achievements and acceptance. By acceptance, I mean: no breeder worth their soul is going to want their successful dogs producing pet quality puppies with your BYB dog. So it will make it difficult to buy your next prospect when you want to do better. Even if you can manage to get your dog finished. (Sending it out with a top handler doesn't make it a better dog when it wins (and with a top handler, it'll win) and it doesn't change the name behind it).

My advice is to find a good Breeder and be patient. Don't buy the first mediocre female you find with open registration from a questionable Breeder just so you can start showing and breeding quicker.

Another piece of advice I learned early on is “The worst puppy from a proven, successful Show Breeder will always be better than the best puppy from a BYB. Especially in the long run when the ancestry plays it's role in the nursery”.

Edit: look, I myself started with crap quality dogs from BYBs. Most of us did. Generational breeder families are actually pretty rare these days. So I know full well how hard it is.

No one took the time to tell me how to approach the successful breeders or to prove I was worthy of their trust. Now 20 years later, I'm applying for my Breeder of Merit-Silver (with nearly 30 champions and a top winning bitch that won BOB at Westminster).

After finishing an entire litter of puppies, honoring a 3 generation contract and honoring multiple co-ownerships, the doors started flying open for me.

It's “hard” because breeders get tired of being screwed over and lied to. It's hard because so many people don't keep their word. It's hard because newbies often don't have realistic expectations. It's hard because too many newbies want to prioritize breeding over showing. (And if breeding is your primary goal, sorry, but we don't want to waste a quality prospect on you that we want finished).

Now I'm in a position that I can pass on what I learned in hopes of making it easier for newbies that come after me and if that makes me a “snob” for trying to help others with the help I didn't receive for years, then that's cool- if that's what you think about someone offering advice to help, then you're not the kind of person I'd want to work with either. And I can tell you with absolute certainty that if “no one is willing sell you a quality prospect” then you're either asking the wrong people, or your approach needs work.

We don't need to sell you a dog- we can show it and finish it ourselves and make sure it gets done. It's up to you to do the work: Ask the breeders if you can go to the show with them and help out, or visit, or just watch. Be willing and ready to “take a dog back in” we all need help getting all our winning dogs back in the ring for winners or BOB. Go to the National and meet people. If you can't travel to meet breeders at the shows or at the National, how are we to believe you'll actually travel to the shows once you've got our dog??

Agree to the co-ownerships. Agree to the strict contracts. And keep your word. Be appreciative when someone does try to help. Learn what's being taught to you. No one likes to waste our breath on people who don't listen. If you think it's hard to get a quality dog as you start out beginning your search, wait until you have a crap quality dog from a BYB. It's not easy to dig your way out of that one if you're not willing to pet them out and start over. (I've started over at least 4 times, and I'm working on another reboot, because I've bred in some traits I don't like).

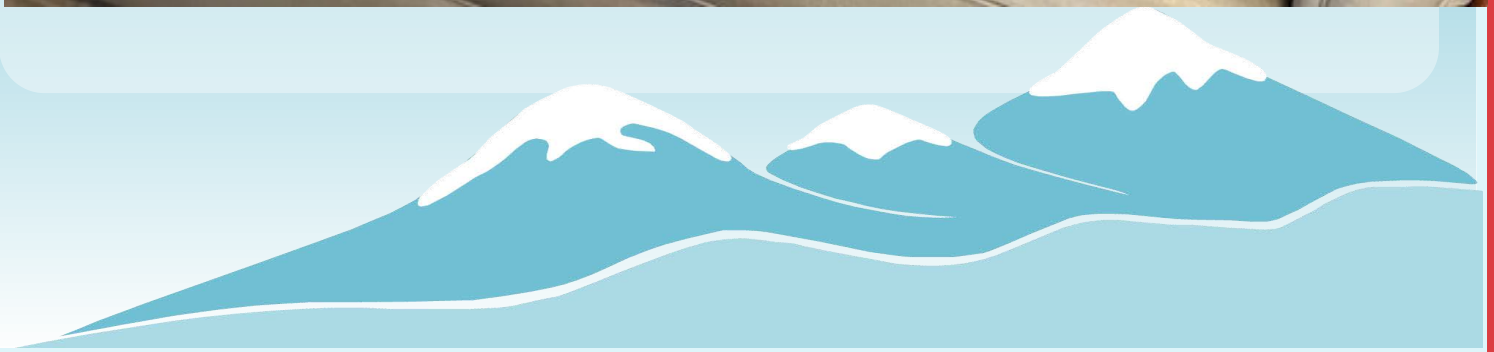

Ontario Director Report!

Hello to my fellow Ontario members!

I cannot believe that we are once again at the end of yet another year! It sure moved along fast.

I was able to get out to a few shows this year and it was nice to see such a selection of Papillons being shown. It has sure been awhile! I hope to get out again in the New Year and looking forward to see what will be out in the ring that are either getting started out – or – some looking to get their finishing points!

On a more serious note though – I'm not sure if the Ontario Members are paying any attention to his new bill that has been presented to us through the CKC – and of course – it could not have been presented at the worst of times as everyone is busy preparing now for Christmas and the New Year festivities. Seems we are getting a double hit with the new laws that they are wanting to put forward about declawing and tail docking etc.

But this new bill, **“Bill 159, Preventing Unethical Puppy Sales Act, 2023”** should be very concerning to our Ontario Members and all other Ontario breeders. If you really think that the CKC is going to be out for the best interest of the membership – please – think again – and you all need to respond negatively to this and if you know of any other Ontario breeders – you need to be sure they speak up as well. We only have until January 4th in order to do so. I am including a message from new member Cindy Hayes – as she went over this bill and the changes and has made a brief note about it.

As Cindy states, we as members of the CKC are already governed by their rules and regulations – now people who have no clue as to what raising dogs is all about is going to start setting upon us their own set of rules and regulations? Of how we do our transactions, record keeping, raise our dogs? Etc. Etc. How do they propose to do this? Who are they going to have going door to door to ensure that 8 week old puppy is still with its possibly abusive mom? To investigate all our placement transactions etc. etc. This Bill leaves us with nothing but more “questions” – no answers – it is all so vague I can't believe that the CKC is even putting it forth to us to respond to! This stuff put forward by government never affects the puppy mills – just reputable dedicated breeders!

A bit more of a breakdown is noted below!! Please take the time to read and please make your voice heard with the CKC before January 4th, 2024!

Submitted by Member Cindy Hayes about “Bill 159”!

Have you seen the email from the CKC about the proposed new Act to amend the Ontario Provincial Animal Welfare Services Act, 2019? Please do not ignore this email.

Under the guise of dealing with Puppy Mills this act proposes (to name a few): **Please note that the last section on the 2nd page, 9 Subsection 69 (1) of the Act is amended by adding the following clauses:**
(e.1) governing the keeping of records for the purposed of section 14.1. Section – this is NOT under the PROHIBITION OF PUPPY MILLS SECTION!!

to prohibit sales and transfers under certain circumstances

to governing the manner and conditions and the regulating of sales and transfers

governing the return of a dog that has been purchased or transferred and refunds

prescribing measures to only protect purchasers and transferees

prescribing requirements for the identification of a dog before sale or transfer

Also, an animal welfare inspector may, for any purpose, demand that the owner or custodian respond to reasonable inquiries. My question on this is, on what grounds?

The Lieutenant Governor is going to prescribe these rules. What does the Lieutenant Governor know about dog breeding?

This act goes to voting in January 2024.

The fines will be under the Ministry of Revenue.

The CKC already has rules and guidelines with regards to dog breeding and the penalties for breeders who do not follow them. Why does the government have to get involved to this deeply involved, when this is something the CKC already does?

I have no problem with laws that are detailed, not these vague ones:

like not being able to separate a puppy from its mother or substitute mother before the puppy is 56 days old, without a note from a vet

What if she is unfit (not feeding or looking after them, hurting her puppies, or even killing them). How soon can the vet get there to see this, hopefully before the puppies are not too badly maimed or still alive.

Then how much will this cost you?

Then the feedback page is so scary, with different statements than what is stated under the Act.

We need to protect reputable breeders, who already look after and take the utmost care for their dogs and following the CKC rules and regulations. Please pass this on to all the breeders in Ontario that you know, so we stop the vote and then get clarification on these proposed rules.
