

## RAINBOW BRIDGE

Sometimes, if you are very lucky, a special dog will come into your life and into your heart. Rumor was one of those special dogs.



He was 2 1/2 when we first saw him. Already a breed champion, he was looking for a new home; I was in need of a new canine partner. My friend, JoAnne Macleod, brought us together. That first day Rumor looked us over, decided we would do, and from that point on was our constant companion, willing to cuddle when that was what was needed and just as willing to try out any activity suggested. He was by far the easiest dog to live with. Friendly to other people, tolerant of other dogs, a non barker, a great traveller, and, above all, always playful and up for a game.



Our ten years together took us to places I never dreamed possible - obedience, nose work, rally, trick training, barn hunt, canine dressage, sprinters, you name it, he would do it. He was Keith's agility partner, earning several agility titles. Up until his death Rumor would still eagerly jump off the couch to head off to agility classes with Keith, something they both enjoyed and something Keith will miss terribly. An obedience champion, a breed champion and a Grand champion trick dog, Rumor also excelled at nose work. This was a sport that seemed designed for him. He loved it and earned his scent work championship, games championship and master championship with the Scent Detection Dog Association, as well as his scent Detection excellent title with CKC.

These public achievements were just icing on the cake though. It was at home where he really shone. A great walking companion, gardening supervisor, ball chaser and tug toy partner, he was also content to curl up with us while we read or watched tv. It is these times that we will miss the most - the warm body snuggled up tight to one or the other of us on the couch, those dark eyes gazing up at me as though I was the most wonderful person on earth, the excited greeting when we came into the house no matter whether we had been gone five minutes or five days, the soft pad of his feet as he followed me from room to room, the wild excitement as I headed to the kitchen to start his dinner, the pure joy that lit up his eyes whenever we competed or even just practiced.



Rumor died at home in his bed after an illness of less than a day and a half. I held him, told him I loved him, thanked him for all our wonderful years together, placed him on his bed then a few minutes later watched him take his last breath. An easy dog right to the end - no heart wrenching decision to make, no final ride to the vet clinic, just a peaceful, gentle good bye.

We know with time the pain will ease and we will be able to look back on his life with a smile, but we also know there will never be another quite like him and the emptiness left by his passing will always be there.

After a very hot dry summer, cooler weather has arrived and finally some rain in our area. Congratulations to all who have been competing and trialing in all the dog sports in the past few months. Thank you to those who sent news and good luck competing in the next couple months.

### **Yvonne Lord – Merritt BC**

The entries have opened for the CARO (Canadian Association of Rally Obedience) Virtual Trial, which has been designated by our Board as a Booster. Stormy and Tempest (and Levi) are all madly practicing and working to be ready for their video runs which will take place between Sept 30 and Oct 10. This is, I believe, the first time Papillon Canada has sponsored a booster at a non-CKC event. Because it is a virtual trial, any papillon anywhere is able to be entered. Papillon Canada has agreed to sponsor ribbons and rosettes, and Louann Hansen and Moira Ure have kindly donated a number of prizes as well! Results and hopefully photos will be in the next issue!

All Stormy's January puppies have gone to their new homes. Tango and Fara have both started collecting points toward their championships and older brother Chaos has finished his. Stormy herself finished her Grand Championship at Merritt in June. I am so proud of Stormy and her lovely babies.

### **Margaret Zacher (Ladymagic) – Kelowna BC**

Sailor and I were able to venture out in the performance arena for 2 weekends. Sailor was just stellar at the Cranbrook & District Kennel Club Trials on June 11-12. We were entered in all 4 obedience and 8 times in Rally over the 2 days. 3 Obedience Open HB (HIC) qualifiers and 2 High In Trials and 7 rally qualifiers (3 Excellent B and 4 Advance B) HIC - 3 more RAE pairs. At the NOKTOC Trials in Armstrong on June 18-19, we were entered in Obedience 2 trials and 4 times in Rally. 1 more Open HB High in Class and High in Trial. As well, as 4 more Rally qualifiers (2 Excellent B and 2 Advanced B) HIC - 2 more RAE pairs.

Sailor has 6 of the necessary RAE pairs, just 4 more to go.

In conformation sailor has done outstanding as well gathering 2 more Reserve Best In Show wins. Sailor also became a father to 3 beautiful babies (1 boy and 2 girls) - all with beautifully symmetrical blazes and personally plus. Sharon Drolet (breeder) will be retaining one of the girls and the other 2 will be heading south with me.

Prada (sailor's mom) will be turning 9 on Sept 16 and Kris (sailor's grandfather) will be turning 17 on Oct 14

Congratulations to all the winners at the Canadian Papillon National – held in Calgary. Sailor and I were unable to attend, due to judge conflict, but look forward to next year.

### **Nancy & Richard Lopaschuk (Nanrich Perm Reg'd) – Cranbrook BC**

I personally have not shown or competed anywhere in Canada this year which is probably a first in the past 55+ years! Richard (Dick) was honored to judge the Papillon Canada National in Calgary on July 28<sup>th</sup> with some lovely dogs competing and then both Dick & I ring stewarded for Alberta Kennel Club for the balance of the weekend. After 33 years of judging, Dick has decided to retire from active judging at the end of this year. His last shows in Canada were in Ontario at the end of August and he has one more assignment in the USA in October.

In August, I did enter 17-month-old Never (CAN CH Nanrich TopFlite Never Say Never) co-owned with Sandy Schumacher in shows in Enumclaw, WA. She showed well and despite having blown all her coat, she did get a Reserve in the All-Breed Show under judge Dr. Steve Keating – 48 Papillons entered.
